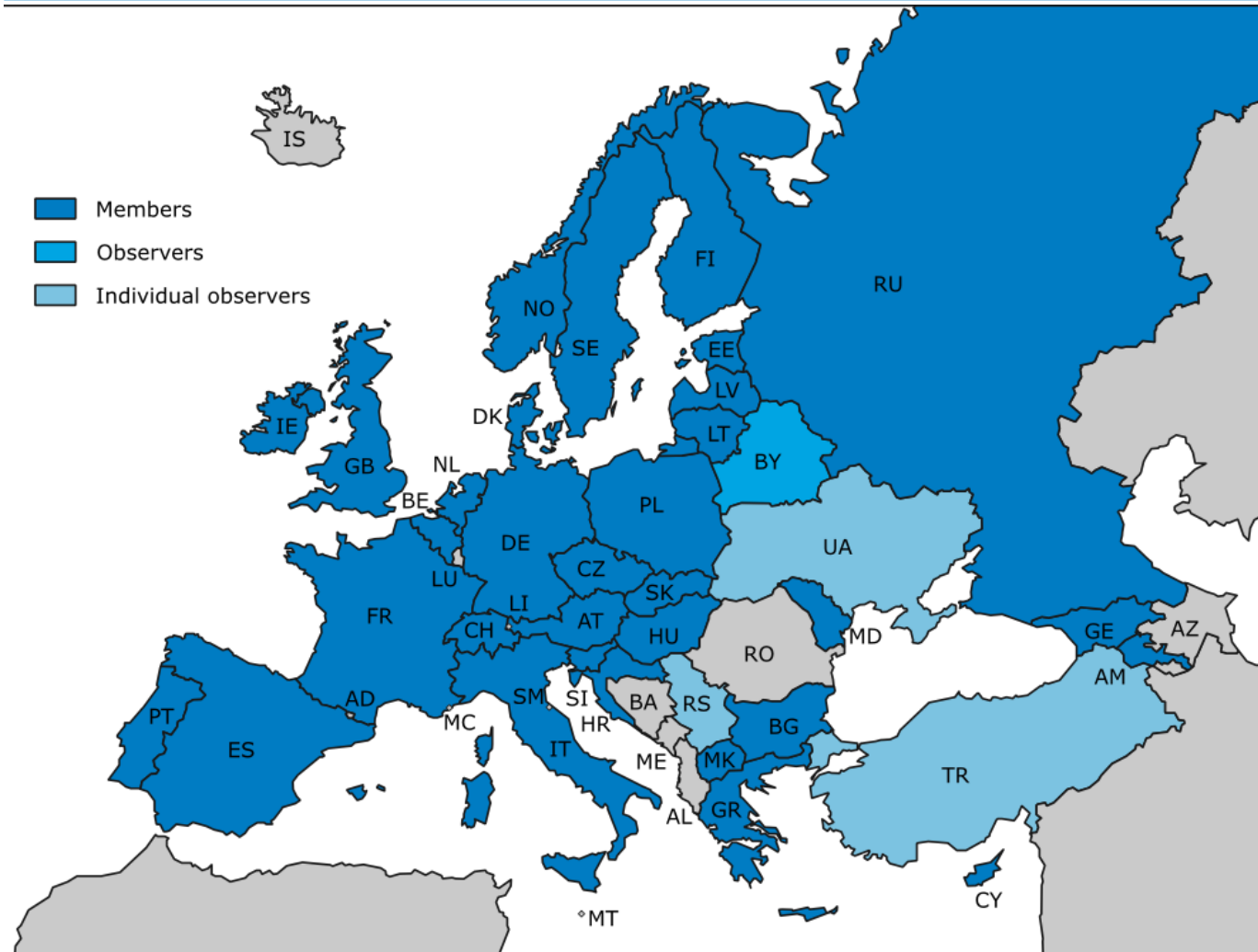

Eurodoc history

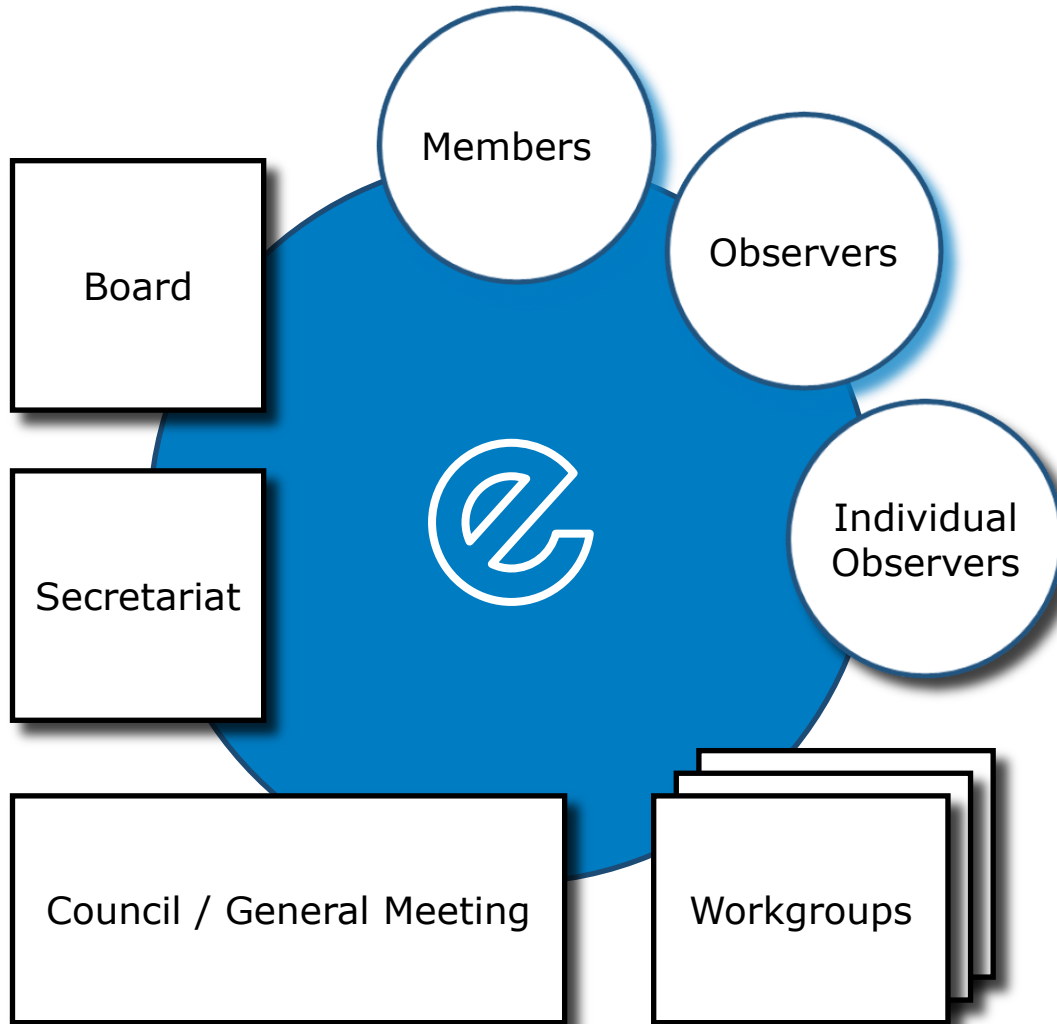


- Arose out of the need of national organisations to cooperate and give young researchers a voice at the European level
- Founded 2002 in Girona, Spain
- Registered 2005 in Brussels, Belgium
- Federation of 32 national organizations
